Review of Activities

Details of activities undertaken during the year are in the full Annual Report available from the District Secretary. The memberships over the year increased by 43 compared to a decrease of 65 last year.. The Council is very grateful for the support it receives from leaders, parents and other helpers and the various grant awarding bodies. A comprehensive programme of activities was planned for the coming year but this has been severely restricted with the onset of Covid 19. The District Scout

Result

During the year Border District Scout Council received a further payment of £50,000 from a legacy, received by the Scottish Council of the Scout Association to be used in connection with the South East Scotland Region - Borders District. This has enabled Borders District to give greater support to the Groups within the Borders District. The movements in the Unrestricted, Designated and Restricted funds are shown in detail in the Financial Accounts attached to this document. An overall deficit of (£3,570) arose in the Unrestricted and Designated funds(£4,178) in 2018. A surplus of £24,483 arose in the Restricted Legacy Fund.

Executive Committee's Responsibilities

Law applicable to charities in Scotland requires the Executive Committee to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the Charity's financial activities during the year and of its financial position at the end of the year. In preparing financial statements, giving a true and fair view, the Executive Committee are required to:-

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- state whether applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements;
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Charity will continue in operation.

The Executive Committee is responsible for keeping adequate accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Charity and which enables them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Reserves Policy

The Reserves represent unrestricted and designated funds arising from past operating results. The unrestricted funds represent the free reserves of the Borders District Scout Council.

It is Borders District Scout Council's policy that general reserves should be held to cover recurring annual expenditure together with any contingency which may arise. The Council also aims to maintain and develop Scouting in the Scottish Borders through leader training and interesting and exciting activities for members.

Borders District Scout Council believes that the current reserves are at a level which broadly meets the aims of the policy.

Subscriptions

Borders District Scout Council collects subscriptions from Scout Groups on behalf of the UK, Scottish Headquarters and the South East Regional organisations of the Scout movements. A small proportion of which remains with the Borders District Scout Council, as disclosed in the Accounts as District Levy.

1 Accounting Policies

a Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards, the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) 2006, and the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005.

b Incoming Resources

All incoming resources are recognised once the Council has entitlement to the resources, it is certain that the resources will be received and the monetary value of incoming resources can be measured with sufficient reliability.

Stock of badges are valued at cost.

d Resources Expended

All expenditure is included on an accruals basis and is recognised when there is a legal or constructive obligation to pay for expenditure.

e Fund Accounting

Details of the nature and purpose of the various funds is set out in Notes 6 to 9.

2 Trustees Remuneration

The Secretaries and Treasurer were paid an honoraria totalling £450 (2019 - £450) but otherwise no staff costs were incurred by the Council during the year. During the year 7 Trustees received reimbursements of expenses incurred totalling £3,433 (2019 - £3,433) which were principally related to travelling expenses and catering.

3 Fixed Assets

Depreciation is charged on the net cost after grants received to write equipment off over 3 years.
